Presentation Topics for “Show Me The Money! Where to Find Funding for Your Business”

Credit is tight but that doesn't mean you're not credit worthy. There are multiple avenues open to you to find cash for your business.

Conventional Banks offer working capital lines of credit, term loans, equipment & commercial vehicles financing, unsecured lines of credit (up to 75K) and for start-ups & new business (under 2 years) - unsecured lines of credit.

But, did you know, you can apply for loans to non-profit organizations such as the Long Island Development Corp. (LIDC) or the Community Development Corporation of Long Island (CDC of LI). These organizations offer up to 250k thru NYS's Targeted Loan Fund, up to 100k thru Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFI's) and up to 50k thru a micro-loans fund.

The US government through its Small Business Administration (SBA) offers SBA 504's (building purchase), 7A (working capital) and SBA Express. Local government initiatives include financial assistance through Industrial Development Agencies (IDAs) and monies for non-profits thru Local Development Corporations (LDCs).

Finally, other options include using your accounts receivable and other forms of your business's assets to come up with the \$'s needed to support your firm's operational needs.
